Written notice of cancellations received before **January 31**, **2020** will be refunded (less the deposit) of the contracted booth space.


Dismantle and Move Out

Tips to Attract Delegates

- Generate a pre-conference buzz. Get delegates excited about your booth before the show. Contact Jana Grubb to place your brand on the Conference website and advertise through virtual inserts. Delegates will see virtual inserts prior to conference and may plan to visit your booth.
- Plan early. Set up a visually attractive booth. Be imaginative, use colour and set up clear signage that can be read from across the room. If giving away promotional items, ensure that you have sufficient inventory on hand.
- Interactives are always a draw. One of the best ways to engage visitors is through hands-on demonstrations. Give delegates the opportunity to watch products being used or let them try out your product themselves.
- Customer service is key. Exhibit space must be staffed at all times; especially during exhibits hall only hours. The booth space should be inviting. Representatives at your booth are your ambassadors.
- Give away promotional items or product samples. When delegates see others walking around with a *cool* item, they'll want to get one too. Once they are at your booth, it's your job to *wow* them with information about your products and services.
- **Wuse social media.** Use the conference hashtag (#STAO2020) and creative wording to catch the attention of delegates. Why should delegates come to your booth? What makes your booth worth the stop?
- **Like bees to nectar.** Booths with a lot of visitors tend to attract more visitors because people want to know what's going on. Serving treats, candy or chocolate at your booth might be a good way to create a crowd.
